Malawi.**

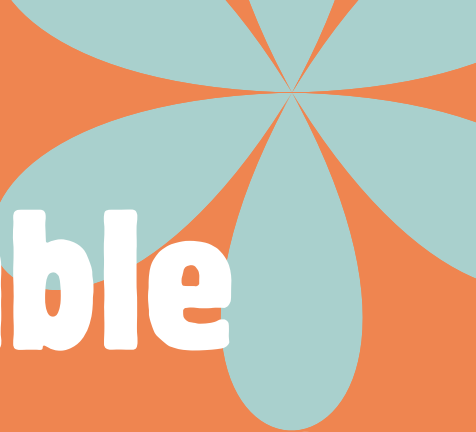


Fundraising!

- Nina and Alice were proud to be hosted by our partners at The Malawi Projects for their Three Peaks Challenge – an event they organised and fundraised for, with Nina and Alice walking alongside them in support
- With Gift Aid, Nina and Alice's fundraising now stands at £10,250
- Together with The Malawi Projects' £10,000 contribution, the event has raised £20,250 for Education programmes in Tilinanu and LSU's health programmes
- A huge thank you to The Malawi Projects for organising such a brilliant event and welcoming us to be part of it

Healthcare

- The Mkoma mobile outreach clinic continued providing medical services this month, with the local community donating use of a church building to house service delivery
- A patient was seen receiving medication at the outreach clinic
- Antenatal care continued at the clinic, with a pregnant woman receiving a mosquito net following her check-up as part of ongoing malaria prevention support for expectant mothers



Sustainable Family Farms

- Farming families at M'ngwizi harvested a combined 309 bags of maize this season, with every beneficiary repaying their maize loan in full – 120 bags returned in total
- This is real proof that the programme's no-interest loan model is working, allowing families to reinvest in the next season without falling into debt
